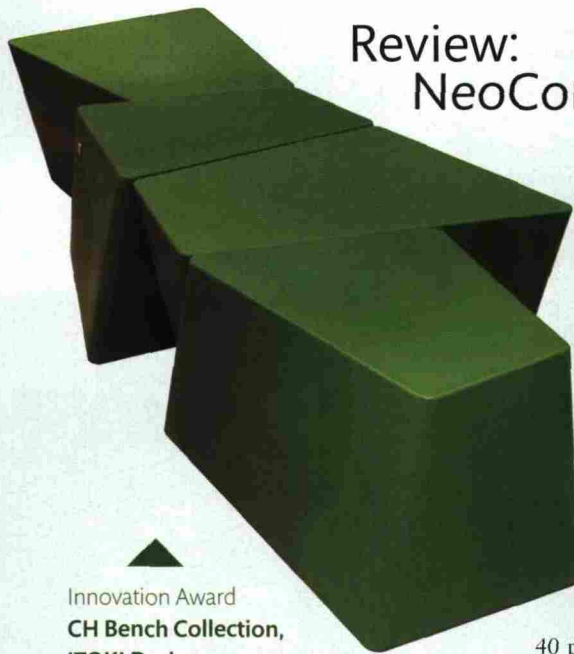

## Review: NeoCon World's Trade Fair

Flexibility and sustainability took center stage at NeoCon 2010. Among the new commercial interior products displaying the first of those attributes was the CH Bench Collection from ITOKI Design (New York), which consists of plastic forms that can be used in multiple configurations and settings, for seating and surfaces. The design (shown) won an Innovation Award in the Best of NeoCon competition.

Products touting an eco-friendly bent included Dimension Walls Eco Panels from MDC Wallcoverings (Elk Grove Village, Ill.). The low-VOC, decorated thermoplastic sheets are made from

40 percent post-consumer recycled content and took home a Gold Winner in the wall treatments category.

In all, 81 products were accorded honors at the Chicago show. - *Matthew Hall*
