It was at [Luna Textiles](#) that we saw cool kicks made out of the new Kinetic Collection. It's also where we bumped into designer friend [Mark Harbick](#) admiring the new patterns, perhaps he will spec them for projects he'll be doing at his newly founded namesake firm.
